
To assure a safe structure and play experience read the **Outdoor Home Playground Safety Handbook** by the CPSC. Go to - https://www.cpsc.gov/s3fs-public/324.pdf

Tools required: Hammer, drill, and 1/8" diameter drill bit

Select a location for your swing set that is level, dry, free of obstructions and surface hazards. Provide a safety zone at least 6 feet of distance from sides of the set and at least 16 feet at the front and back to provide a safety zone for swinging. See Guidelines and Warnings on next page and refer to Outdoor Home Playground Safety Handbook.

Once you are confident of a properly leveled location, with safety zone, place set as desired on the leveling blocks. Stakes sold separately are highly recommended to better secure the set. Drive stakes through holes in blocks into the ground and fasten to sides of posts or legs using screws. Drilling 1/8" pilot holes into the wood will ease driving screws.

Leveling blocks are reversable for use with sets with angled legs or vertical posts. (See diagrams)




Vertical post installation


When installing on corner post - Most manufacturers provide rebar stakes. Please install rebar stakes as per recommendation on your swing set manual.

> When installing on rock wall or access ladder rails use Small Block angle side up.


Angled post installation




When installing on Beam legs use angle side – To better secure set, use Rebar stakes shown in Diagram with Screw (purchased separately)



To help level your swing set, you may purchase and use additional blocks. The interlocking nubs will align blocks for stacking. Caution – Do not exceed two blocks per stack.





Small Blocks can be stacked with angle side up for access ladders, rock walls and angle supports attached to vertical posts. Stack only two high if placing blocks under entire unit.
